

The WSJ/Vistage Small Business CEO Confidence Index rose for the third consecutive month, a 68% gain from April's low of 44.7.






Small businesses were twice as likely to report expectations for revenue increases rather than declines over the next 12 months






While less than one-third of CEOs report a COVID-19 surge in their area, 35% report an employee, customer or vendor tested positive






