

The WSJ/Vistage Small Business CEO Confidence Index continues slow climb

Expected changes in U.S. economy over next 12 months among small businesses



Compared with a year ago, how have overall economic conditions in the U.S. changed?



Small business projections for revenues over next 12 months




Expansion plans for the year ahead regain momentum after January dip among small businesses



Do you plan to require that your employees receive a vaccine?




- No, vaccines will be recommended but not required
