


Small business expectations for improvement in the U.S. economy reaches new record


Expected changes in U.S. economy over next 12 months

Compared with a year ago, how have overall economic conditions in the U.S. changed?






Small business projections for revenues over next 12 months








Expansion plans continue to climb; over two-thirds of small businesses plan to expand their workforce


Plan to increase workforce, fixed investments in next 12 months

The Paycheck Protection Program was the primary source of funding for small businesses during the pandemic

Beyond PPP funds, how have you raised capital since the start of the pandemic?
