The WSJ/Vistage Small Business CEO Confidence Index **rose to 111.5** in the January 2014 survey, **up from 108.4** in the prior month and 94.2 in last year's January survey.


When asked about prospects for the year ahead, 41% expected the economy to improve, up from 38% in December and 26% last January.

Just 7% of all small firms expected the economy to worsen during the year ahead, down from 13% last month and last year's 24%, and the smallest proportion ever recorded.


